

Do you have a valid ticket?



Valid for the Gurtenbahn are

- General Abonnement (incl. GA Night), GA FVP
- Junior travelcard
- Children's Co-travelcard
- SBB day, saver day and school day passes
- Libero travelcard with Zone 101
- Libero modular travelcard with Zone 101
- Bern-Ticket / Bern Welcome
- ID card for passengers with a disability (Companion travelcard)
- Free carriage of one accompanying person and/or one trained dog
- Dog Pass
- SBS (Swiss Cableways Association) tickets
- Route ticket to Gurten Kulm



The following are partially valid on the Gurtenbahn (purchase of a reduced ticket)

- Half-price travelcards
- Swiss Travel Pass Adult (children are free)
- HTA-FVP (Half-Fare travelcard for FVP holders)
- Military in uniform and marching orders
- Civilian service card during deployment



Not valid on the Gurtenbahn are

- Libero day pass / one-way tickets
- Libero multi- and group day tickets
- City Tickets Bern
- Multi-ride tickets
- Free travel tickets
- Bike season ticket and bike day passes
- Interrail

You can buy your ticket via the ticket machines at the stations, via the ticket shop Gurtenbahn: <u>Gurtenbahn: Up to Berns home mountain</u> or the usual public transport apps (e.g. SBB Mobile, öV Plus, etc.) or activate automatic ticketing (e.g. SBB Easy Ride, FAIRTIQ, etc.).Self-checking applies. Random checks will be carried out and persons with a missing or invalid ticket will be fined.
